Reflection

Epiphany comes from the Greek word epiphaneia meaning "appearance" or "manifestation" and refers to the manifestation of Jesus Christ to the World. Having established the word epiphany. Let us summarize the readings of today:

- 1) The first reading from the prophet Isaiah 60:1-6 emphasizes about the Gentiles who come from distant places, attracted by the splendor of Jerusalem, bringing gifts, and tenderly carrying the sons and daughters of the Holy City.
- 2) St. Paul in the second reading to Eph 3:2-3, 5-6 Paul preaches the mystery, hidden from all eternity, that in Jesus Gentiles are heirs with Jews.
- 3) Whereas in the Gospel of Matt 2:1-2 The Magi come with gifts seeking the king of the Jews and upset Herod and all Jerusalem. Epiphany is the origin of gift giving at Christmas Time. Gifts bring many happy surprises, but they also raises many problems if not checked.
